SITUATION

- Initial allocation through the CERF of USD 7 million to humanitarian interventions approved.
- Humanitarian response accelerates and emergency supplies reach beneficiaries.
- Security situation generally calm but flare-ups triggered by political announcements continue.
- Relief efforts coordinated by Government Ministries in partnership with UN, Kenya Red Cross and NGO community.
